


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Joy T. Pearce, Show Low, Arizona, has requested a permit to remove 3,600 cubic yards of screenings to be used in the construction of the Cibecue Day School.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized to issue a permit to Joy T. Pearce for 3,600 cubic yards of screenings paying the appraised price of 15 cents per cubic yard and removing said screenings within 90 days from the date of the permit.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
