## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has designated the Cibecue Road Project as a first priority on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, a new school is being constructed in the Cibecue area, and

WHEREAS, a road is needed from the Cibecue Bridge to the school site.

BE IT RESOLVED that the said proposed road from the Cibecue Bridge to the new school site be included in the Cibecue Road Project and to give first priority with said road project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Area Director of the Bureau of Indian Affairs be notified of the Council's wishes in the matter.

The foregoing resolution was on June 1, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
