RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Apache County Board of Supervisors has levied a personal property tax against the lease homesite improvements at Hawley Lake, and
- WHEREAS, information has been received that a school tax will now be imposed to support the McNary schools, and
- WHEREAS, the County has provided no services in the Hawley Lake area or acknowledged previous requests by the Tribe for such services.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council and the Tribal Attorney cooperate with the Hawley Lake Homeowners Association in every way possible to effect an equitable reduction in the Hawley Lake taxes and further request services from the County for the taxes which are collected.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
