RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit Contract No. 14-20-0450-5026, approved August 14, 1964, between the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Seller, and Reidhead and Chlarson Lumber Company, Inc., Purchaser, and as amended November 13, 1964, stipulates that all logs from the unit be sawed in the Purchaser's sawmill at Cibecue, Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, it may be in the best interest of the parties to permit some volumes of logs to be manufactured at the Purchaser's sawmill at Carrizo, Arizona.
- BE IT RESOLVED in consideration of the mutual benefits and efficiencies, it is agreed that, upon the discretion of the Superintendent and the Tribal Chairman, volumes of logs cut on the Cibecue No. 1 Logging Unit may be manufactured at the Purchaser's sawmill at Carrizo, Arizona.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other stipulations of the contract shall remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was on July 19, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
