

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Tenneco Oil Company was the only bidder on the Fort Apache Oil and Gas Lease Sale conducted at the Fort Apache Agency on August 10, 1966, and


WHEREAS, they have requested a permit to perform geophysical reconnaissance work covering lands in the Block 1 Sale, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be to the best interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Tenneco Oil Company be granted permission to perform geophysical reconnaissance work.

BE IT RESOLVED that Tenneco Oil Company, upon the payment to the Tribe of the sum of \$250.00, is hereby granted a non-exclusive prospecting permit for oil and gas for a period of six months on tracts 1 through 73, totaling 177,840 acres.

The foregoing resolution was on August 17, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
