## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Gomez and Associates, engineers for the to be constructed Community Building has advised the Tribe that an additional sum of money will be needed to provide for the remodelling of Alchesay Hall and the building as a new Community Building, and
- WHEREAS, the Federal Government will supply additional funds on a three to one ratio as that provided by the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Community Building will be in existence for many years and be of great benefit to the Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from Tribal funds on deposit with the United States Government an additional sum of \$12,500.00 to cover the added cost of remodelling Alchesay Hall.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized to sign the amended specification and drawing and application and any and all other documents necessary to effectuate the Federal Government participating in building the new Community Building and remodelling Alchesay Hall.

The foregoing resolution was on September 8, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
