RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the complexity of the various local, state and Federal programs which are, or may be, vital to the growth of the reservation economy require more travel than anticipated by members of the various committees, the Chairman, appointed delegates, and other tribal employees.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated and added to Section 1, Paragraph A, 01-01-7704 5.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of \$1500.00 is hereby appropriated and added to Section 1, Paragraph B, 01-02-7704 3.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said sum is to be effectuated from savings accrued from other sections of the budget.

The foregoing resolution was on October 19, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
