

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council encourages all Apache people to vote on Election days,
and

WHEREAS, many people live great distances from the polling places, and


WHEREAS, these people have no means of transportation to said polling places.

BE IT RESOLVED that all Tribal Police cars and personnel are hereby directed
to furnish transportation to the polls of all persons living at some
distance from the polls.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Police personnel on that day shall
work closely with Mr. James D. Sparks, the Chairman of the Get Out
the Vote Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on November 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of
10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the
Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27,
1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
