

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the education of the Indian children on the reservation is of a prime importance to the welfare of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Elementary School District No. 20, Navajo County, Arizona, has requested a lease of additional land on the reservation for the purpose of a training site for vocational agricultural students and for other school purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is authorized for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to execute a 25 year gratuitous lease beginning July 1, 1960 with an option to renew for an additional period of 25 years with the Elementary School District No. 20, Navajo County, Arizona for the purpose of training site for vocational agricultural students and for other school purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area leased is located on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and described as follows:

Commencing at the quarter corner common to Sections 12 and 13, Township 5 North, Range 22 East, G. & S.R.B. & M., Navajo County, Arizona; thence run S.61°06'00"E., 809.70 feet to an axle; thence run S.36°02'40"W., 648.81 feet to the true point of beginning; thence run N.66°17'30"W., 257.76 feet to an iron pin; thence run S.18°44'10"W., 281.44 feet to an iron pin; thence run S.05°09'30"W., 432.30 feet to an iron pin; thence run S.59°46'50"E., 314.45 feet to an iron pin; thence run N.54°23'10"E., 843.99 feet to an iron pin; thence run N.66°17'30"W., 647.23 feet to the true point of beginning and comprising an area of 10.28 acres.

The foregoing resolution was on November 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
