


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


AS, Logging and exclusion of fire has resulted in heavy over-  
stocking of reproduction and pole stands in the ponderosa  
pine type, and

AS, growth that should be accumulating on crop tree stems is  
dissipated into growth of many thousands of stems which  
will never reach a salable size,

RESOLVED that funds be made available in a form specifically  
designated for timber stand improvement projects in a  
manner similar to those available for forest pest control.

The foregoing resolution was on December 8, 1966 duly adopted by a  
majority of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White  
Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article  
Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe,  
approved by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of  
Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
October 3, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
