FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, in Carrizo a new well is needed and the existing water lines need improvement and maintenance work done thereto, and


WHEREAS, the United States Public Health Service has offered to provide funds to do this work, and

WHEREAS, it was suggested that the Tribe appropriate \$1,000.00 as its share of the cost of the well and line.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from the Tribe's funds on deposit the sum of \$1,000.00 to defray the Tribe's share of the cost of drilling a new well and improving and maintaining the lines at Carrizo on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on December 8, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
