RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 67-55 provided for a contract by and between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Mr. James D. Sparks, Manager of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, there was some misunderstanding as to the amount of salary provided, and
- WHEREAS, the budget approved by Resolution No. 67-71 provided for the salary of \$10,500.00 and Resolution No. 67-55 authorizing the contract provided for a salary rate of \$10,000.00, and
- WHEREAS, the conditions of approval of Area Director stated that the salary should be the same as that stated in the contract which is very vague as there was no contract at the time.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized and directed to sign a contract with Mr. Sparks on the same terms as were provided in Resolution No. 67-71 at an annual salary of \$10,500.

The foregoing resolution was on June 21, 1967 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
