


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 60-5 the Tribal Council passed an inspection by the U. S. Public Health Service regulations, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to amend said resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 60-5 be amended by providing that all food handlers on the reservation shall be given a physical examination prior to employment and that all food handlers who are now working, who have not had a physical examination, shall likewise immediately secure such examination pursuant to regulations as prescribed by the Medical Officer in charge of the U. S. Public Health Service Hospital, Whiteriver, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
