RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 65-42 and Resolution No. 67-123, the Tribal Council established certain Community Action preference programs, and
- WHEREAS, the industrial and recreational development component was not listed, and
- WHEREAS, it is of utmost importance that the industrial and recreational development on the reservation be given great preference.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the industrial and recreational development component of the Community Action Program is hereby given high priority.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe authorizes and directs the Chairman to sign all application blanks and any other necessary documents to enable the Tribe to participate in the industrial and recreational development component under the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
