RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to conserve and maintain its wildlife resources in accordance with sound game management practices, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to provide the maximum hunting opportunities for all tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, responsibilities for fish and game management onthe Fort Apache Indian Reservation is vested in the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the game management section and the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise has made recommendations to the Tribal Council for the 1968-69 Game regulations, season dates and bag limits.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the attached game regulations, season dates and bag limits as recommended by the White Mountain Recreaation Enterprise be approved by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on June 26, 1968 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
