
RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Chairman's, Vice Chairman's and Athletic automobiles have great mileage and all in need of repair, and

WHEREAS, the maintenance cost would make it not feasible to retain these automobiles.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury of the sum of \$8,000.00 to make up the difference of the trade in allowance of the purchase price for the purchase of three (3) new automobiles, one for the Chairman, one for the Vice Chairman and one for the Athletic Department.

The foregoing resolution was on January 8, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1953 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
