✓ WHEREAS, the intricate part of a ski run restaurant marina complex is the right to sell spirituous liquor, and


WHEREAS, the Council has been informed that there might be available, a Series 6 Arizona State Spirituous Liquor License, and


WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Development Corporation, Inc. does not have sufficient funds to pay the application fees for the issuance of said license.

✓ BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby transferred from savings within the budget the sum of \$1700.00 to be used by the Fort Apache Development Corporation, Inc. to make application for and pay the fees thereof of a No. 6 Arizona State Spirituous Liquor License.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Administrative Manager is hereby directed to determine where the said savings can be made.

The foregoing resolution was on March 17, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
