FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Joe Tony Jaquez was found guilty in Federal Court of illegally killing and butchering a North Fork steer, and

WHEREAS, said Joe Tony Jaquez, under oath, testified that Claude Boddie was an accessory to the crime, and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 6 of the Law and Order Code, the two men are lawbreakers.


BE IT RESOLVED that said Joe Tony Jaquez and Claude Boddie be ejected from the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, never to return.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Southwest Forest Products in McNary be notified of the said eviction.

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (q) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1950 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
