## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Fort Apache antelope surveys and classification counts were not completed at the time the 1969-70 game regulations were approved, and
- WHEREAS, surveys now indicate a huntable surplus is now available and the Tribal Game Management section has made recommendations for a Tribal and a non-member hunt.
- BE IT RESOLVED that 40 antelope permits be authorized for Tribal Members and 25 antelope permits be authorized for non-members.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other regulations pertaining to antelope hunting in Resolution No. 69-76 and 69-77 shall remain in effect.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
