

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe adopted Resolution No. 69-137 requesting that an application be prepared for a Series #16 Liquor License for Hon Dah Restaurant, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that a Series #6 Liquor License will be available in Navajo County, January 1, 1970, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council considers a Series #6 more valuable to the Tribe and that a Series #6 Liquor License will provide a more economical facility at Hon Dah Restaurant.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that an application be prepared and submitted to the State Liquor Control Board by the Fort Apache Development Corporation, Inc.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that license fees from contingency funds of the White Mountain Apache Enterprise are to be loaned to the Fort Apache Development Corporation, Inc.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 69-137 is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Manager of the White Mountain Apache Enterprise, the Fort Apache Development Corporation, Inc. and the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are hereby authorized to prepare a management contract for the operator of the Hon Dah Restaurant.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
