WHEREAS, the Whiteriver School District No. 20 of Whiteriver, Arizona is going to operate the to be built vocational school, and


WHEREAS, before the said school district can so operate, the school must have a lease from the tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign a 25 year lease with the Whiteriver School District No. 20 at a monthly rental of \$359.16, said lease having been read, in its entirety, to the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said lease and income therefrom is to be pledged as security for the Economic Development Administration Loan.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
