
WHEREAS, this project was sub-contracted to Century Geophysical Corporation, Tulsa, Oklahoma, and


WHEREAS, Mr. Kenneth Thompson of Century Geophysical Corporation has presented a statement of goals, strategies and planning review procedures to the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approves the said statement of goals, strategies and planning review procedures as presented by Mr. Thompson.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Century Geophysical Corporation is hereby requested to proceed with the next phase of the contract as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
