FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, there was presented to the Tribal Council, guidelines for Cibecue and John F. Kennedy Day School Boards, and

WHEREAS, the guidelines have great merit.

BE IT RESOLVED that the guidelines for the Cibecue Day School and John F. Kennedy Day School Boards is hereby approved and adopted by the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Boards be commended for adopting these necessary guidelines.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
