

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Reservation Creek Beetle Control Logging Unit is included in the five-year Timber Sale Program, and

WHEREAS, the spruce on this unit is currently undergoing a moderate bark beetle infestation.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Reservation Creek Beetle Control Logging Unit as presented in the Forest Officer's Report and Proposed contract covering the recommended sale of this timber and subject to minor changes and administrative adjustments by the Approving Officer be sold to the Fort Apache Timber Company based on the ratio system of the gross monthly product value of sales received by Fort Apache Timber Company, F.O.B. mill, less purchased lumber for the sawlog timber. The rate charged for stumpage, except for pulpwood, is to be adjusted monthly as specified in Tribal Resolution No. 69-103 and Area Director's Memorandum of August 22, 1969.



Pulpwood, cords	10,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pulpwood be sold for \$1.20 per cord.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tribal Resolution No. 66-20 be amended to permit construction of logging roads and logging of timber within the wilderness area where necessary to prevent spread of the beetle infestation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and secretary are authorized to execute the contract and related documents necessary to administer the sale of the timber for and on behalf of this council.

The foregoing resolution was on March 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
