

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company has proposed a procedure to overcome the lack of advance road construction, and

WHEREAS, if this procedure is adopted Fort Apache Timber Company, with the help of the Tribal Land Operations Program, will construct the majority of roads used by the gypo loggers, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe will reimburse Fort Apache Timber Company or the Tribal Land Operations Program for actual costs, and


WHEREAS, this program if initiated this year will cost approximately \$300,000.00, and

WHEREAS, there also exists deficiencies in authorization for the road suspense accounts amounting to \$18,373.01 (Ryan Ranch \$1,582.20; Willow Creek \$14,523.31 and Cyclone Lake \$2,267.50).

BE IT RESOLVED that authorization is given to increase the Fort Apache Timber Company Road Suspense Account by \$318,373.01 to initiate the advance road construction program and to give the additional authorization for roads which have been constructed.

The foregoing resolution was on March 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
