## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Willow Creek Logging Unit, Contract No. H50C-1420-6794, was purchased by the Fort Apache Timber Company and approved by the Area Director on March 26, 1969, and
- WHEREAS, there is a small patch of timber, near Paddy Butte that is adjacent to the Willow Creek sale and is a part of the Maverick Unit, but was inaccessible to cutting by Southwest Forest Industries, Inc., and
- WHEREAS, Southwest Forest Industries, Inc., has completed cutting on the Maverick Unit and the cutting date of their contract expires March 31, 1970, and
- WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company has requested a modification of the Willow Creek Boundary to include this patch of timber that contains approximately 500,000 b.f. for cutting in 1970, and
- WHEREAS, it is to the advantage of the Tribe to include this timber in the Willow Creek sale.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the boundary of the Willow Creek Unit be modified to include this timber.

The foregoing resolution was on March 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
