RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, EDA 08-1-0064 is in the final stages of pre-construction, and
- WHEREAS, the Architect for the project, Mr. Henry M. Arnold, will be unable to prepare the project for bidding until the tribe pays Mr. Arnold \$2,812.50 for services rendered, and
- WHEREAS, this \$2,812.50 is an approved project expense which can be paid for with project funds once they are obtained.
- BE IT RESOLVED that \$2,812.50 be appropriated from tribal funds to pay Mr. Arnold for his expenses to date.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this amount will be repaid to the tribal treasury when approval to disburse EDA funds on the project is obtained.

The foregoing resolution was on March 18, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretaryof the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
