## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise Plan of Operation was approved on April 12, 1968, and
- WHEREAS, Area Director's approval of the Plan of Operation required the Enterprise become inactive on completion of construction of Alchesay Hall, and
- WHEREAS, the Enterprise may be reactivated to construct another project by Resolution of the Tribal Council and approval of the Area Director, and
- WHEREAS, financing for the construction of thirty-five (35) low rent houses has been approved by a Federal Agency, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise will assume the function of Prime Contractor for construction of the thirty-five (35) houses.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby approves the reactivation of the White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise so that it may serve as prime contractor to construct thirty-five (35) low rental houses.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache
  Tribal Council is hereby authorized to accept any conditions of
  approval that may be requested by the Area Director.
- The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
