RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the U. S. Public Health Service has recommended that the Tribe agree with the Student American Medical Association to provide at least two health science students and community consultants to provide health supervision, coordination and technical assistance to the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Student American Medical Association will provide all the funds necessary to finance the program.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign the agreement, read to them, by and between the Tribe and the Student American Medical Association for health services to be rendered on the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
