

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Highway Department, at the request of the Tribe and Bureau of Indian Affairs, has made a traffic safety study on State Route #73 within the Whiteriver community, and

WHEREAS, Highway Department personnel have submitted a proposed plan for certain changes and improvements to this Highway which will provide for greatly increased safety within Whiteriver.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council approves the plan as submitted including the proposed signing and traffic control.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council requests that the State Highway Commission (1) Approve a no parking zone along State Route #73 throughout the congested zone within Whiteriver beginning at the intersection of the Community Action Program office and extending south to the south line of the Whiteriver Garage; (2) Construct a curb along both sides of the Highway through the community to delineate highway roadway and to provide turnouts as required to provide access to parking where permitted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council accepts and approves the lighting plan as proposed by State Highway Department safety engineer and will attempt to implement this plan as soon as funding arrangements can be made.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council wishes to express its appreciation to the Arizona State Highway Commission and the Arizona State Highway Department for their interest and concern in helping to rectify the dangerous and hazardous conditions that currently exist on State Route #73 within Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
