## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. John A. and Mavis M. Fowler and LeRoy and Caroline A. Huddleston desire to exchange their leases i.e. LeRoy and Caroline A. Huddleston desires to assign the Irish's Trading Post to John A. and Mavis M. Fowler and John A. and Mavis M. Fowler desires to assign the Country Kitchern to LeRoy and Caroline A. Huddleston, and

WHEREAS, the Council has no objection to this proposed exchange.

- BE IT RESOLVED that permission is hereby granted to LeRoy and Caroline A. Huddleston to assign their lease, Contract No. 14-20-9 H52-9 to John A. and Mavis M. Fowler.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that John A. and Mavis M. Fowler is hereby granted permission to assign their lease, Contract No. 14-20-0H52-7 to LeRoy and Caroline A. Huddleston.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said assignment, among other things, shall provide that the assignors shall be bound by all the terms and conditions in the respective leases.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Trader's licenses be approved for the respective new business of the Fowler's and Huddleston's.

The foregoing resolution was on June 10, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
