RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Harward Peddie has requested a lease of the lands between the Whiteriver Service Station and Econ-o-wash to construct a service Station and garage thereon, and
- WHEREAS, the tribe is interested in realizing income from this valuable piece of land.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized to sign a standard twentyfive year lease for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe with Mr. Harward Peddie.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the land be appraised in order to arrive at the minimum annual rental therefrom.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that before the lease is executed, a metes and bounds description of the premises and a plat where the building is to be constructed, must be presented to the Chairman of the Tribe for his approval.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
