RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Sandra Perry has requested a lease near the Whiteriver airport to construct a Beauty Shop, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that there is a need for a Beauty Shop in the Whiteriver area.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to execute a lease between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Mrs. Sandra Perry, provided that Mrs. Perry furnish a legal description of the area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mrs. Perry shall abide by the recommendations made by John L. Dietemann, Field Sanitarian of the U. S. Public Health Service.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mrs. Perry construct a small oxidation pond for the disposal of liquid wastes. Said pond to be 20' x 20' and 4' operating depth and that it be located as far away from any dwelling or business as practical and the area shall be fenced.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent is authorized to issue a traders license to Mrs. Sandra Perry.
- The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
