RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Becker Creek Logging Unit, Contract No. H50C-1420-6576, was approved by the Area Director on August 28, 1968 and purchased by the Fort Apache Timber Company, a Tribal Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, a portion of the timber to be cut was designated within 28 individual clear-cut blocks, and
- WHEREAS, these clear-cut blocks were designated for cutting prior to the development of the Sunrise Ski Complex which is now within a portion of this clear cut area, and
- WHEREAS, clear-cut Blocks 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 27 and 28 should not be cut because of the Sunrise Ski Complex.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe consents to the exclusion of the above-mentioned clear-cut blocks from the Becker Creek Logging Unit and that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to sign all documents pertinent to this timber contract modification.

The foregoing resolution wason September 10, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
