

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the cutting date for the Diamond Creek No. 4 Logging Unit, Contract No. 1420-0450-5845, approved by the Area Director, October 11, 1965 between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Fort Apache Timber Company expires December 31, 1969, and


WHEREAS, a small volume of Engelmann spruce has to be felled and left intact through September 1970 to attract a 1970 flight of Engelmann spruce beetle, that are brooding in a clear-cut block, and

WHEREAS, this spruce cannot be salvaged in 1969.

BE IT RESOLVED that the contract cutting expiration date be extended to December 31, 1970 and that the date to complete all other contract obligations to December 31, 1971, and that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to sign all documents pertinent to this extension.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
