RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- THEREAS, all of the present funded Community Action Programs are beneficial to the ! Mite Mountain Apache Tribe and have great merit, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe desires that these programs be continued and refunded.
- MEREAS, the Executive Director of the Community Action Program has recommended that the Tribe make application for additional needed programs which would benefit the Tribe including, but not limited to, a Youth Program, Vocational Field Training Program, programs covering Emergency Food and Medical Services, Alcoholism, Day-Care Centers and a Medical Health and Assistance Center for older Apache Indians, and
 - MEREAS, it was recommended that all the above said programs be intergrated into one project called the Apache Intergrated Comprehensive Family Assistance Program.
 - BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Director of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to execute the refunding of all Community Action Programs now being operated on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and that he is further authorized and directed to take action necessary to establish the above mentioned Apache Intergrated Comprehensive Family Assistance Program.
 - HE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized to sign any and all application forms to renew the present funded projects and to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate the programming and consummation of the Apache Intergrated Comprehensive Family Assistance Program.

The resolution was on October 5, 1970, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the !Thite Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1950, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (43 Stat. 984).
