RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the problem of lack of teeth in the adult population is quite significant, and
- WHEREAS, the Public Health Service has no funds available at this time to construct dentures, and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Removable Prosthesis of the University of California, Los Angeles, Dental School has proposed a summer dental clinic to provide dentures at a nominal cost of five dollars (\$5.00).
- BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that a letter be written acknowledging the great need for this service.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all available help and assistance be given to the people carrying out this project next summer.

The foregoing resolution was on December 9, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
