

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the council is of the opinion that the use of a radio station in Show Low would disseminate information to the Apache people, and

WHEREAS, there is a great need that the Apache people receive this information so that they can be appraised of the actions of the Tribal Council and other non-tribal agencies.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$200.00 to be spent from the Public Relations Account to be used for purchasing one-half hour per week for two months of radio time from Station KVSL, Show Low, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on December 9, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
