RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development has granted funds to the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to construct sixty five (65) low-rent houses known as Arizona 16-17, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal members are greatly in need of low-rent units, and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development has agreed to permit the White Mountain Apache Tribe to construct these units through the auspices of the White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized and directed to sign an agreement with the Housing Authority and the Department of Housing and Urban Development for the construction of said low-rent houses.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to sign all other documents necessary to expedite the program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized to reactivate the White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise to carry out this construction in accordance with the plans and specifications approved by the local housing authority and the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The foregoing resolution was on June 22, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
