RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe is pleased with the programs of the Mutual Self-Help Housing Program, and

WHEREAS, there is additional need for this type of housing in the Canyon Day Community, and

WHEREAS, the Canyon Day Community has requested additional housing.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Housing Authority plan and program fifteen (15) new houses in the Canyon Day Community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Douglas Antonio, Edgar Kahn and Ambrose Bread be given first consideration by the Housing Authority.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
