RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration has a new public works program designed for immediate implementation in areas of high unemployment, and
- WHEREAS, high unemployment is our most critical problem, and
- WHEREAS, our Economic Development Officer has given assurance that a complete and reasonable application concerning Area Rehabilitation and Beautification can be made and posted in the time available.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and Secretary are authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to initiate and consumate this most desirable project.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council guarantees, should the project be implemented, that the tribe will complete the project in a timely manner to the mutual satisfaction of EDA and the tribe, and that the project will be completed at a cost not to exceed funds available.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
