RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, A Day Care Center, (Cha Gha Che Day Care Center) has been established in Whiteriver for the care of children of working mothers, and
- WHEREAS, a Plan of Operation is now being prepared by the Officers of the Cha Gha Che Day Care Center, and
- WHEREAS, the Federal Government will not contribute funds toward this Day Care Center until it is proven to be a going project, and
- WHEREAS, the Parents of Children pay a weekly fee of \$15.00 for the first child and \$5.00 for each additional child, and the mothers have held numerous fund raising events in order to raise sufficient funds to operate the Day Care Center and have also requested and received numerous donations from various people and businesses throughout the State of Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, sufficient funds are not available to purchase all the equipment food and supplies necessary to operate the Day Care Center in a satisfactorily manner at the present time.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of \$5,000.00 is hereby authorized for use by the Cha Ghe Che Day Care Center.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$4,000.00 of this sum is to be expended from the Contingency Fund and \$1,000.00 is to be expended from the donation given to the Tribe by Universal Films.

The foregoing resolution was on December 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
