RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the present Tribal authority for prescribe burning was effective until 1971, and
- WHEREAS, a new prescribe burning plan for 1971 through 1976 has been prepared, reviewed and approved by the Forestry Committee, and
- WHEREAS, in an effort to reduce the damages and loss to the Tribe from wild fires, an active prescribe burning program is beneficial.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed prescribe burning program to reduce fire losses for 1971 through 1976 is approved.

The foregoing resolution was on December 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
