RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal members living in the Cedar Creek Community have asked that a Policeman be stationed permanently in their community, and
- WHEREAS, many cases of vandalism, burglaries, and other illegal acts have been reported to the Tribal Council and the Law and Order Committee, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council and the Law and Order Committee have made an investigation and found that there is a need for a policeman to be stationed in this community.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Agency Criminal Investigator in charge is hereby authorized and directed to station a policeman permanently in the Cedar Creek . Community.

The foregoing resolution was on December 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
