RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe enacted Ordinance No. 47, on January 16, 1963, establishing the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority in order to eliminate unsafe and unsanitary housing conditions on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the affairs of the Authority are managed by a Board of Commissioners composed of five persons appointed by the Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Council has determined that some members of the board of commissioners have not attended meetings, thus preventing business to be transacted by a quorum not being present, and
- WHEREAS, the Council desires to replace those members failing to attend meetings called by the Authority.
- BE IT RESOLVED that Mrs. Delta Brewer, Whiteriver, Arizona is hereby appointed to fill the unexpired term of Mrs. Cornelia Hoffman, commencing January 12, 1972 and ending May 16, 1975.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mrs. Reva Truax, Carrizo, Arizona is hereby appointed to fill the unexpired term of Mr. Lynn Cody, commencing January 12, 1972 and ending May 16, 1974.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Sidney Ethelbah, Whiteriver, Arizona is hereby appointed to fill the unexpired term of Mr. Leroy Huddleston, commencing January 12, 1972 and ending May 16, 1972.

The foregoing resolution was on January 12, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
