RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Clifford Anable has been accomplishing the Reservation Program Officer function during the past year under a Tribal Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and
- WHEREAS, he is currently involved in several projects of utmost concern to the Tribe, and the Tribal Council feels that there must be no interruption in this effort.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that they strongly urge the Bureau of Indian Affairs to continue to provide for the services of the Reservation Program function.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Clifford Anable be retained in the position with the facility of and use of a Buy Indian Contract or satisfactory employment at the earliest possible date on or before February 1, 1972.

The foregoing resolution was on January 12, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
