RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a number of complaints have been received from ice fishermen of snowmobiles on the lakes, and

WHEREAS, lakes are for fishing and the only income comes from fishing permits, and

WHEREAS, snowmobiles create annoyance and danger to fishermen.

BE IT RESOLVED that all motor powered vehicles be restricted from all lakes on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on January 12, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
