RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, due to the Administrative Officers of the Community Action Program having failed to present and get approved a budget in time, and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Officers failed to notify the employees that the Washington Office of Community Action Program did not pay them because of the failure to have an approved budget, and

WHEREAS, the said persons conscientiously performed the services and should be paid.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasury, the sum of not to exceed \$13,000.00 to pay the Community Action Program workers for the period of time they worked and were not paid for by the Community Action Program.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
