WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman has received an invitation from Commissioner Bruce to participate in the new Reservation Acceleration Program, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the proposed program and feel it is of great benefit, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that it is an excellent opportunity for the Tribe to express themselves with Indian input.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that we participate in the Reservation Acceleration Program and submit to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs the information requested by February 19, 1972.

The foregoing resolution was on February 3, 1972 dulynadopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
