RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the United States of America, acting through the Indian Health Service, Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, has agreed with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to install domestic water supply and sewage disposal facilities for Indian homes in the East Fork and Seven Mile communities, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, a resolution requesting the said Indian Health Service to construct the said water and sewage system for the Mutual-Help House Program in the said East Fork and Seven Mile communities has been adopted by the said Housing Authority, and
- WHEREAS, an agreement has been requested by the said Indian Health Service by and between the said Health Service and the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority; said agreement having been read to the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to execute the said agreement for the construction of domestic water supply and sewage disposal facilities for Indian homes in the East Fork and Seven Mile communities, Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the Wite Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
